► **DELEGATIONS**

Alberni Clayoquot Regional District (ACRD) and Port Alberni Port Authority (PAPA) were in attendance to speak on old Alberni Plywood Lot plans. The discussion started off with ACRD advising Council of planning with Alberni Engineering hover craft repair project. Council advised ACRD of a specific claim that Tseshah has underway regarding reserve at Polly's Point.

Chief Councillor Hugh Braker reported ongoing preliminary discussions with Hub City Fisheries and potential partnership with ice plant and freezer operations.

Chief Councillor Hugh Braker also reported on forestry agreement with province and discussion was tabled until next meeting for resource staff to be present for their input to discussion.
