► **DELEGATIONS**

Haahuupayuk Principal and Board of Directors met to discuss plans of building new playground for school and sharing old playground materials with Nation (i.e. Youth Centre and Paper Mill Dam playground). Also discussed was proposal of shared education worker providing assistance with students and connecting with parents. A Working Group to be developed to collaborate ideas of shared education worker and further details on budgeting for proposed position.
