
- Please remember those who travel to and from Vancouver we need you to bring in the Ferry receipts, for that travel.

#### SIGNS OF A

## STROKE



A "Stroke" is a sudden loss of brain function.

Caused by the interruption of flow of blood to
the brain or the rupture of blood vessels in the
brain

You may be having a Stroke if you experience:

- ▼ sudden paralysis or numbness of the face, arm, or leg (usually on only one side of the body)
- ♥ sudden loss of speech or trouble understanding speech
- ▼ sudden loss of vision (often in one eye only) or double
  vision
- ♥ sudden dizziness or loss of balance or coordination
- ▼ sudden severe and unusual headache (often described as
  "the worst headache of my life" that starts suddenly) with
  no known cause

If you experience any of these symptoms, it is a medical emergency. Call 911 or your local emergency number immediately.




