### Clarification of Notice of New Election

It has come to my attention that there may be some who have misunderstood an aspect of the Notice I issued on October 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020 regarding the cancellation of the election.

In particular, it appears that some may have taken the statement, "*I have recommended to Tseshahat First Nation Administration and Council that it is in the best interest of the community to cancel the current election ...*" to mean that Administration and Council were responsible for cancelling the election.


I want to make clear that **the decision to cancel the election was solely and entirely mine** as Electoral Officer and that neither Administration nor Council played any part in the decision. The term "recommended" is used to indicate that my decision has significant implications for Administration and Council which require deliberation and action from both.

I hope that this clarifies the situation for those who misunderstood the meaning of this aspect of the October 14<sup>th</sup> Notice.
