IMPORTANT NOMINATION MEETING INFORMATION

Notice is hereby given that a meeting of the Eligible Electors of the Tseshahat First Nation, will be held at the **Tseshahat Administration Building at the Tseshahat Reserve on January 5th, 2022 beginning at 5:00PM and lasting until 8:00PM**, for purpose of Eligible Electors nominating a candidates for the positions of one (1) Councillors for the next ensuing term of office.

CRITERIA TO BE CANDIDATE:

- Only electors may nominate or second a nomination of a candidate.
- Only electors who meet requirements of a "Candidate" as set out in the Code (Tseshahat First Nation Custom Election Code (2004)) may be nominated as a candidate.
- No Elector can nominate or second more than two candidates.
- Those electors nominated for the office of Councillor shall indicate their decision, in writing and deliver it to the Electoral Officer within four (4) clear days (96 hours) after the nomination meeting.
- All Candidates who accept their nomination must provide the Electoral Officer, within seven (7) days, a short one-page profile that will be made available to the electors.


