Notice is hereby given that the **Tseshahat First Nation** has called a Nomination Meeting on **January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022** in accordance with the *Tseshahat First Nation*, for the purpose of eligible Electors nominating a candidate for the Office of Council (1 Councillor) to be elected in the next By-Election on **February 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2022** for the ensuing term of office.

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- a) Only electors may nominate or second a nomination of a candidate.
- b) Only electors who meet requirements of a "Candidate" as set out in the Code (Tseshahat First Nation Custom Election Code (2004)) may be nominated as a candidate.
- c) No Elector can nominate or second more than two candidates.
- d) Those electors nominated for the office of Councillor shall indicate their decision, in writing and deliver it to the Electoral Officer within four (4) clear days (96 hours) after the nomination meeting.

- e) All Candidates who accept their nomination must provide the Electoral Officer, within seven (7) days, a short one-page profile that will be made available to the electors.

**NOTE THAT DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC, ELECTORS ARE ENCOURAGED TO BRING THEIR NOMINATION FORMS FILLED OUT TO THE NOMINATION MEETING. THE FORM MAY BE DOWNLOADED BY ALL ELECTORS AT THE WEBSITE LISTED AT THE BOTTOM OF THE PAGE.**

The Election Code, supporting Nomination documents, and the official Voters List of all Eligible Electors shall be posted and available during regular business hours at the Tseshahat Office; can be requested from the Electoral Officer; and will be available to download at:
