The ?uu?atumin yaqckwiimitqin (Doing it for our Ancestors) Alberni Indian Residential School Project (AIRS) is sharing that GeoScan will be returning to conduct Ground Penetrating Radar (GPR). The company will operate their machines over the area for two weeks, starting September 12, 2022.

GPR scanning will continue to be conducted with compassion and care so as not to disrupt possible burial locations. We ask once again that GeoScan crew be given space to do their work. This work is difficult for our people and all those carrying memories connected to AIRS, but together we are working to find answers from the past and bring truth to the present.
