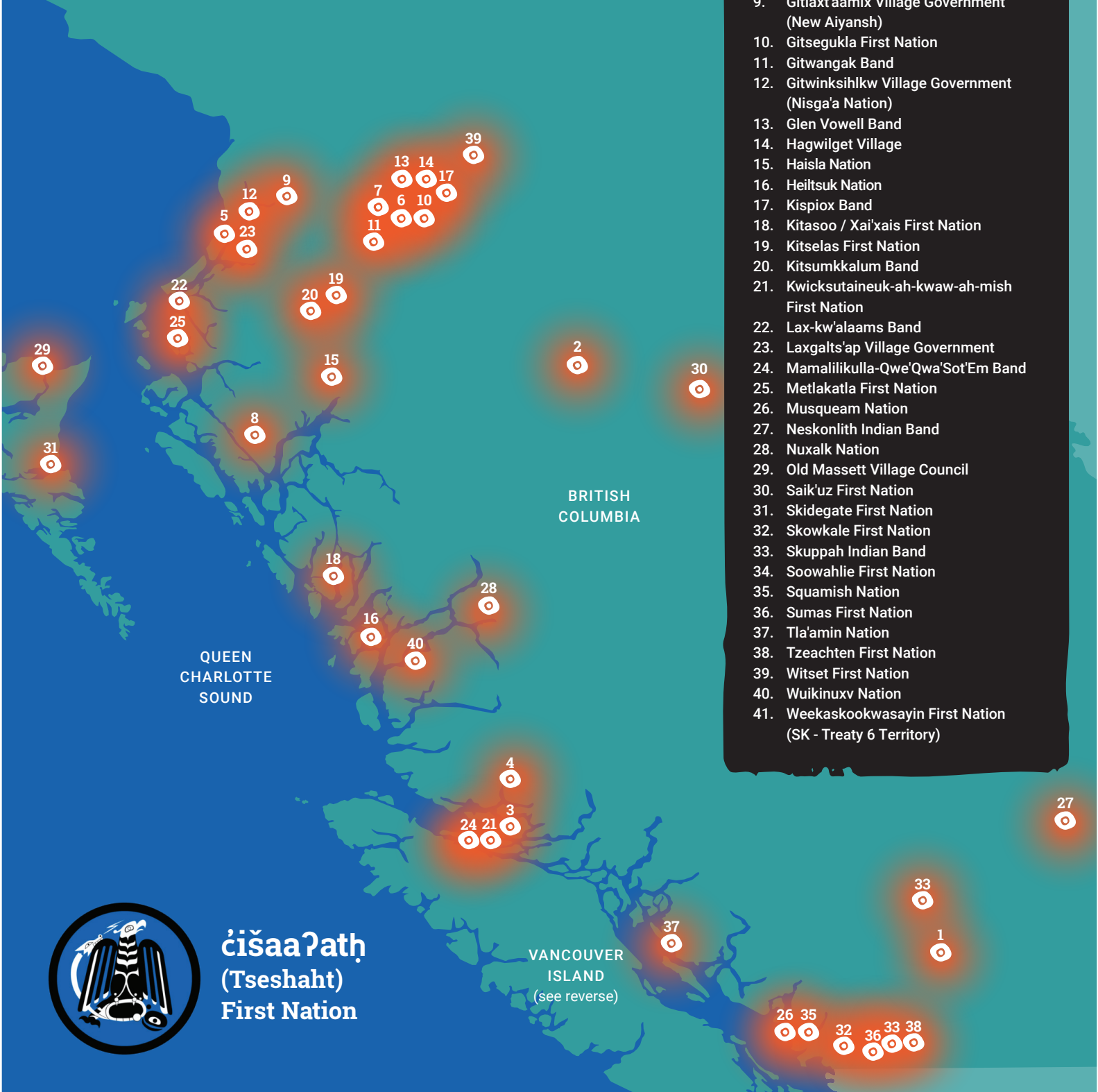


Nations who had students attend the Alberni Indian Residential School (AIRS)

Available attendance records for AIRS (Quarterly Returns, Admission and Discharge Records from 1941-1973) indicate that students came from at least **90 different reserve communities**. This translates to **over 70 First Nations** that are captured on this map.
