Fishdays are designed to provide to our community.

Just a reminder to take what you bring, leave only your footprints.

Elders & Permanent Disability:

- 1. Elders who are band members age 60+ may attend all three days. However, they can only have someone designated to pick up their share on **Fridays**.
- 2. Elders who would like someone to pick up their share, or have it delivered will need to contact the Fisheries Administrative Assistant (Tamara Mack). The information you will need to provide will be:
 - ✓ Your legal name (as per membership list)
 - ✓ Name of person picking up
 - ✓ Will this be a one time pick up only? If not, is it for the remaining Elders Fishdays.
- 3. If you are a helper, you will need to be added to the "**Helpers List**" to ensure we can keep track of who gets the helpers share.

Adams list:

- 1. Out of respect to the late Adam Shewish's directive to add widows and pregnant woman to the disability list. We renamed "**Disability**" list to "**Adams**" list to show respect and encompass all that the definition entails.
- 2. Adams List consists of Widows, Pregnant, and Short-term disability.
- 3. Members who are on the Adams list must choose which days they attend. If they attend Friday, they are unable to receive a share on Saturday & Sunday.
- 4. Members with a disability are asked to submit a doctors note to the Fisheries department. It should state whether your disability is short-term or Permanent Disability.
- 5. If you are a helper, you will need to be added to the "**Helpers List**" to ensure we can keep track of who gets the helpers share.

Community:

- 1. Community Fishdays on Saturdays/Sundays are for band members who are 16+.
- 2. You must be present to get your share. You cannot pick up for anyone else during these days.
- 3. As you arrive you must check in and be added to a list. You will need to put your tote in line to ensure that the line is in order as per list. If you are not on the list when hand out starts, you will need to check in get in and be placed in line.
- 4. Members who appear intoxicated, under the influence of drugs or members who have been barred from Fishdays by council will be refused.
- 5. If you are a helper, you will need to be added to the "**Helpers List**" to ensure we can keep track of who gets the helpers share.

Helpers:

- 1. Helpers can be anywhere from the age 12+
- 2. Helpers under the age of 16 will need to have a Parent/Guardian sign a consent form to be able to participate in helping.
- 3. Any helpers under the age of 16 must have Parent/Guardian present while helping.
- 4. Helpers who under the age of 16 are only eligible for the helpers share.
- 5. If you are a helper, you will need to be added to the "**Helpers List**" to ensure we can keep track of who gets the helpers share.
