## BEACH KEEPER ATTENDANT SUMMER STUDENT POSITION

*Employment opportunity for Tseshahst members*

The Tseshahst First Nation Administration Office is now accepting applications from Tseshahst members for a Beach Keeper Attendant. This is a summer student position.

### POSITION SUMMARY

This position will be administered under the guidelines of summer student employment funding with the intent of enabling a Tseshahst student to gain practical work skills and experiences in the Parks & Recreation field of work. The student will also be provided a unique opportunity to work in the Broken Group Islands and learn more about Tseshahst history and traditional way of life.

Hours of work will be 40 hours per week, following the Beach Keeper Program's 4-day rotating schedule, which includes work days and time off from the Broken Group Island work site.

### QUALIFICATIONS

- Tseshahst Youth (age 15-30) who is a student returning to school in September.
- Familiar with on the water safety protocols and with small vessel operations,
- Able to perform light maintenance/ janitorial duties to assist with the upkeep of park facilities and camp sites,
- A genuine interest in pursuing a career in the Parks & Recreation field of work,
- Good communication skills; able to interact positively with park visitors and assist with the orientation of visitors to park regulations.
