The Tseshaht First Nation Administration Office is now accepting applications from Tseshaht members for a Youth Recreation Assistant. This is a summer student position.

POSITION SUMMARY

This position will be administered under the guidelines of the Canada Summer Jobs Program, aiming to provide a Tseshaht student with practical work skills and experiences in the field of community and youth recreation. The student will have the opportunity to assist in delivering recreational programs and events for youth and elders, both within the community and externally. Additionally, the role involves maintaining activity spaces and supporting other duties as directed by Supervisors or Managers.

Hours of work will be 30 hours per week, with potential evening, weekend, and holiday shifts. This role is designed to enhance the student's understanding of community service and provide valuable work experience in a supportive environment.

- Tseshaht Youth (age 15-30) who is a student returning to school in September.
- Must have a Social Insurance Number.
- Must be willing to work some events, weekends, and/or holidays.
