POSITION SUMMARY

The Recreation Worker reports to the Prevention Manager. They are responsible to schedule and coordinate delivery of a range of youth programs with a focus on enhancing the health, physical well-being and development of Tseshahst Youth, including seasonal sports and recreational activities.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

The successful applicant will possess skills and experience in the following areas:

- Grade 12 or equivalent, and/ or a certificate in Youth and Recreation, or Child and Youth would be considered an asset. A combination of education and experience will be considered.
- 2 years of work experience, operating youth recreation programs.
- A keen interest and desire in working with Tseshahst youth, a demonstrated ability to monitor youth, and to lead by example and be a positive role model.
